



The Ohio State University Faculty Club Art Program Fact Sheet

The Club

Established in 1923, the Faculty Club is located on The Oval at Mirror Lake Hollow in the heart of The Ohio State University Campus. The Club is a busy, sought after venue for business meetings and private functions as well as dining by members. The Club's art exhibition areas are heavily used and are open to non-members.

The Exhibitions

The Ohio State University Faculty Club has a long established tradition of displaying art exhibitions of work selected from The Ohio State University faculty, staff and alumni. The Club is also very interested in displaying art collections held by Ohio State University faculty, staff and alumni or estates of the same.

THE POLICIES

1. While the exhibitor is always consulted, The Ohio State University Faculty Club reserves the right to all final decisions regarding the selection of art for display at the club and the hanging of the exhibition.
2. The club expects that 90% or more of the art pieces installed will be for sale. The club will work with an exhibitor who wishes to exhibit a few quality privately owned pieces, award winning pieces, or pieces borrowed back for the exhibition. Such pieces will be labeled NFS (Not For Sale) and included in insurance. When placing any art for sale at the club, the exhibitor agrees that in the event of a sale, the club will receive 20% of the sale price listed. The club will handle all sales, collecting State of Ohio taxes. The club will mail out the exhibitor's 80% portion of the sale two weeks after the exhibition dismantle date. ALL SALES FINAL.
3. The Ohio State University Faculty Club will host an opening reception for each exhibition at which cheese and crackers, vegetable crudités and an assortment of fresh seasonal fruit will be served along with fruit punch. The Club offers the artist the option of purchasing wine at cost from the Club to be served to guests during the reception. If wine service is selected, the Club requires the artist to take care of all charges incurred by the close of the reception. A total of 100 invitations will be printed, addressed and mailed by the Club from the artist's list at no cost to the artist. Names and address may be e-mailed to lisa@ohio-statefacultyclub.com. Additional invitations can be mailed from the artist's list if the artist agrees to pay all costs associated with the additional invitations and mailing. The Club will mail additional invitations to its internal mailing list of art program supporters. Receptions are usually held on Friday evenings, as the Club's calendar permits. One Sunday a month may also be available.
4. The exhibitor is responsible for delivering the artwork framed and ready for hanging with all wiring, hooks, etc. double checked, appropriate for the club's hanging system, and then for picking up the work at the end of the exhibition. Artwork must have complete identification on the back. The Club is unable to store any works not displayed.
5. The Faculty Club provides insurance for artwork while on display at the club. Values are set by the price list submitted in advance by the exhibitor.
6. The artist is responsible for submitting to the club approximately six weeks before installation the following: publicity materials (including five photos of the artist and the artwork), the guest list for 100 invitations, the list of titles of art to be exhibited and the insurance list (sales prices) for all work to be exhibited.
7. The Ohio State University Faculty Club holds an annual art auction each March. As part of exhibiting with the club's art program, artists are encouraged and invited to make a donation of a piece of their to the annual art auction.
